

## Maintainability of advanced configurations of features

Most features have a checkbox, and a large number of preferences to permit configuration.

Some needs are more vague:

Thus, they end up as advanced configurations and perhaps profiles.

But

- There is a maintainability challenge
- It's difficult for new users to get started
- There may be profiles for various versions of Tiki, but there are no (as of now) upgrade profiles. Ex: a diff of the two profiles, like our SQL patches)

Could we imagine something like [Workspace UI](#) where there is a GUI mode which is fine for the simple use cases, but easily evolvable to advanced mode?
